The size restrictions are the same as for regular EID entry:

Set the resolution to 72 or 300 DPI

For horizontal images set the maximum size at 1024 pixels

For verticals set the maximum size at 1024 pixels

Make sure your image is in jpeg format

The file name should indicate which competition you are entering the image into: examples

for wildlife: PatStarr_BirdsOfCourse_W_jpeg

or for spring landscape: PatStarr_GrandTetons_SL_jpeg
