If you enter, Jim recommends (only) that you keep the numbers near 4 color and 4 monochromes. We also will be asking for help putting up the display stands, and "manning" the area during the show. The Fair is over Memorial Day, Friday before will be the acceptance date, so bring your prints to Oaks Park on that day. Jim will make sure we all get the flyers for the show and remind you to enter the Theme competition: Red Hot and Rolling!

The Cascade Chapter of PSA (Jim Baker again) will sponsor a SMALL PRINT COMPETITION. This will be held in the King City Town Hall on the third weekend of September. Acceptances will be due 10 days before the show opens, and you may enter 4 each of Color and Monochrome.
